2. Open 2'.
3. Open 2'3.
4. Open 2'6.
5. Open scurry 2'9.
6. Open 3-3'3 (if time and sufficient entries permit)

7. Best 1,2,3 year old not to exceed 14.2hh at maturity.
8. Best 1,2,3 year old to exceed 14.2hh at maturity.
9. Best 1,2,3 year old pure bred mountain and moorland large and small breeds.
10. Best 1,2,3 year old part bred mountain and moorland large and small breeds.
11. Best 1,2,3 year old to make a riding pony/show pony.
12. Best 1,2,3 year old to make a riding horse/hack/hunter.

**CHAMPIONSHIP-** 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 7-12 to compete.

### Ridden Classes

(Not to commence before 11am)

13. Lead rein pony. Snaffle bridles only.
14. First ridden.
15. Family horse/pony.
16. Best combination. Not exceeding 13'2hh.
17. Best combination. Exceeding 13'2hh.
18. Mountain and moorland pure bred. Small and large breeds.
19. Mountain and moorland part bred. Small and large breeds.
20. Show/show hunter pony.
21. Best condition horse/pony.
22. Best coloured.
23. Best cob/cob type.
24. Riding horse/hack/hunter.
25. Best Veteran. 15 years and over.

**CHAMPIONSHIP-** 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 13-25 to compete.

### Rules

1. The committee of the Plymstock and District Equestrian Club has taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the safety of all persons and animals attending the show. However it is expected everyone take all reasonable steps to ensure their own safety and obey any lawful instructions given by the show officials and stewards. The committee and Duchy College will not in any circumstances hold itself or be held responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to vehicles, animals, people or property. Veterinary expenses are the animals owners responsibility.
2. Any physical or verbal abuse directed at a judge, steward, committee member or exhibitor will lead to instant dismissal from the show ground.

3. We advise that hard hats conforming to EN1384 or PAS015 MUST be worn and correctly fastened by any person (child or adult) whilst mounted on the show ground.
4. The judges decision is final. Judges directions should be carried out. The awarding of a lower placing must be understood and accepted.
5. All vehicles to be parked in authorised areas only.
6. Riders will be banned from the show ground for the misuse of whips or spurs and ill treatment of animals.
7. Competitors in all rings (including championships) must be correctly dressed in hats, boots and jodhpurs/breeches.
8. The committee reserves the right to alter any of the events.
9. Dogs are not allowed at Duchy College under any circumstances.
10. The committee reserves the right to refuse entry without a reason being stated.
11. Any objection must be made in writing within 10 minutes of the class being held, together with a deposit of £10, which will be returned if the objection is up held.
12. No refunds to be given under any circumstances.
13. A novice horse/pony is one that has not won a first prize in the respective class previous to current year (except where stated in the schedule)
14. Practice ring rule; only competitors jumping may use the warm up jump and it must not be higher than the jumping class in progress.
15. No rider under the age of 3 years old to compete.
16. No horse or pony under the age of 4 years old to be ridden on the show ground.
17. A charge of £2.00 per competitor for first aid will be made.
